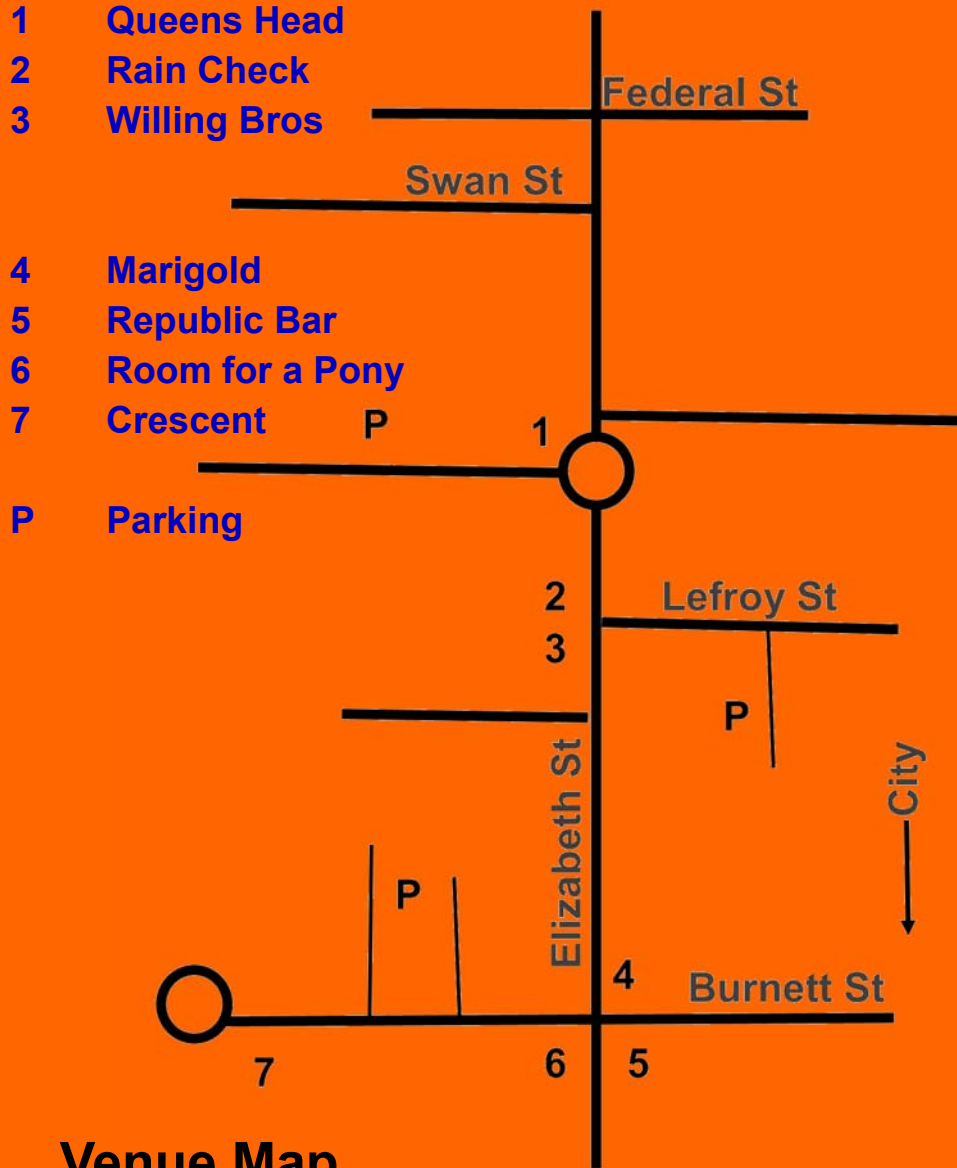

COVID-19 information at Hot August Jazz

Our top priority has, and always will be, to ensure the health and safety of everyone attending, working and performing at Hot August Jazz. We've had discussions with the venues and been diligent with the Health Department regulations to ensure we have a festival that is safe and fun. A lot of how this works lies with you...the festival patron.

We strongly encourage you to follow these basic principles:

- ***Wash and sanitise your hands as often as possible.***

- ***Be sure to sign the attendance sheet with your name and phone number at each venue you attend. This is to help us locate you if there are any issues with a COVID-19 presence.***

To help with physical distancing at the Festival, there will be a limited capacity in each of the venues. Venues will control how many can enter at a time. In some cases bookings will be required, seating will be allocated and you will be seated with the people you have booked with.

Details of each venues booking arrangements are available in the Hot August Jazz program and on our website.

In all venues capacity will be reached once the seats are all full.

The venues will also control their environment regarding the cleaning and sanitising of their establishments.

The jazz club will have a cleaning crew for the stage area in each venue.

The stages will be cleaned at each band changeover to protect our musicians and crew. Keep an eye out for our "Safety Angels"

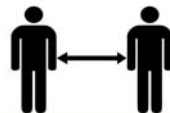
