
Roz Pearson Quintet



PRESIDENTS REPORT 2023/24

Before I start I just want to talk about this great team you have in your committee. Everyone brings some individual talent and ideas to the table and as a team we get to bring you some great jazz events. I can't single them out as I don't want to forget someone; but I am sure you get the gist of what I am saying.

The other wonderful group of people is you. You come every month, rain hail or shine. We love bringing you some great music, a night to socialise and meet new people. Thank you.

We know that some of our committee members will move on, some of us have been here a loooong time. Our secretary of 8 years, will be leaving the committee but still around to help out. We thank Irene for her wonderful work with us and especially for her cookies at our meetings. We also thank Roz Pearson for coming on committee last year and helping us out.

Now down to the nitty gritty. In the last 12 months we have had 14 bands at our jazz club nights, over 260 musicians and 28 volunteers at Hot August Jazz, and roughly 42 musicians volunteering their time and talent at our other festivals and jams. This means we have paid over 300 musicians to perform for us. I know we don't pay a lot of money but we do like to think we are helping them with a gig and with some exposure. That makes it worthwhile.

Also a big thank you to Carol in advance because she has put such a great effort into fundraising with Bunnings and our major raffle. There are some great prizes on offer for our raffle which will be on sale from April.

Now as we move forward we need to consider succession, we need new blood, new ideas, and some more energy to keep this wonderful club going. As you can see from the accounts we are OK financially, it is man power we really would like to see.

We are only too happy to teach people how to write grants, how to program, market, organise events and manage money. These are skills that will help people, especially the younger ones, get ahead in their endeavours toward a music career.



It took a lot of financial reports and paperwork before we became incorporated again in 2004 when we became the Hobart Jazz Club Inc, no longer the Jazz Action Society. All my time on committee, I have loved the feeling of satisfaction that I have given something back to the industry; BUT, I think the time is coming for me to step aside. I would like to see the 20th HAJ this year as President but that means 2024/25 will be my last year as President. In March 2025 you will need to elect another person. I am more than happy to help in the back ground.

Let's make this year super. We have Ross in a couple of weeks, we are heading to St Helens in June for our Taz JazzFest and Hot August Jazz will be 20 this year. I say bring it on and let's party.
