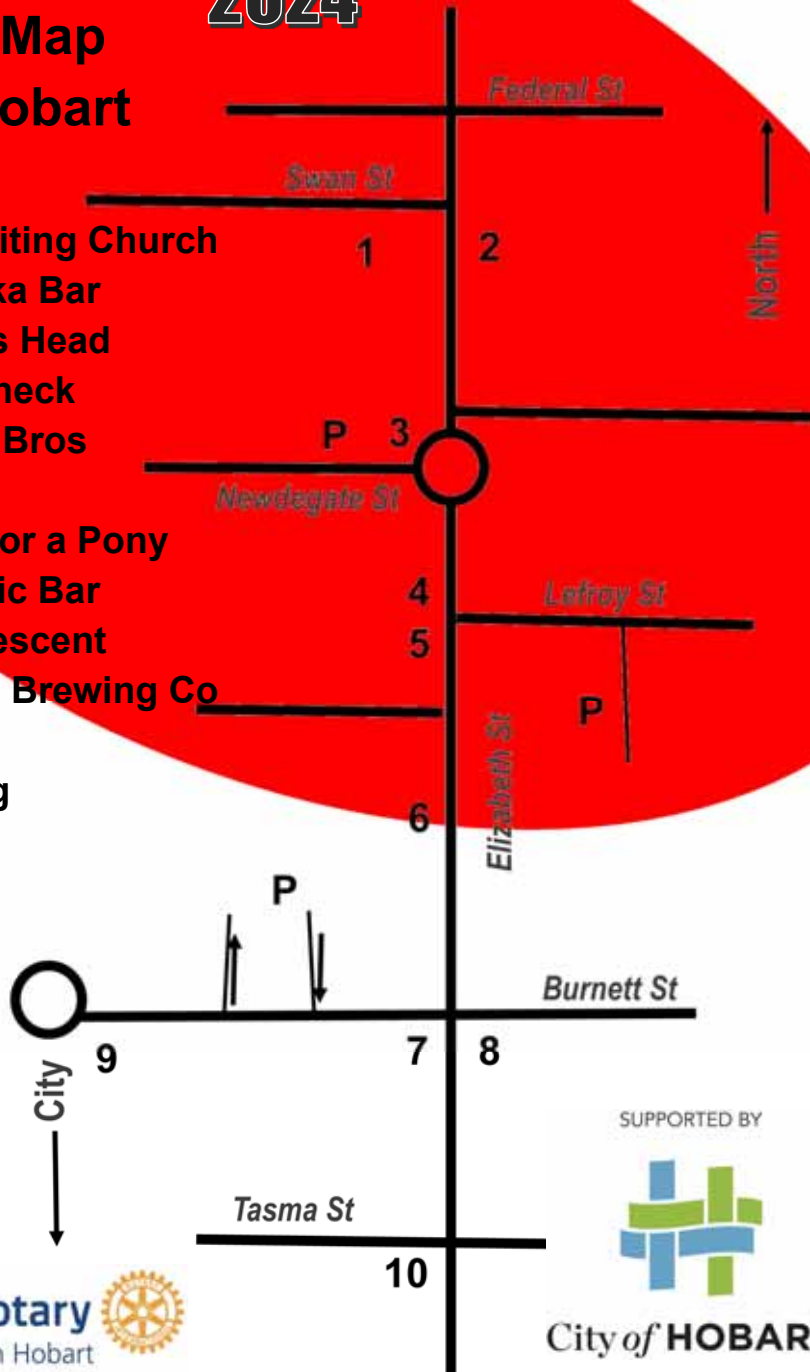

**28th August 2005 was our first Hot August Jazz Festival.**  
 We thought North Hobart the perfect location as it had the venues, good cafes and everything was in walking distance. We started with twenty-one bands (including solos, duos and larger groups) in six venues that year. Bands did two sets each.



We thought we might get a couple of hundred people but we were blown away when numbers almost reached 2,000. People wandered from venue to venue, taking advantage of the fine food and hot jazz.



Over the last twenty years we have had sixteen venues participate and around two hundred and fifty musicians per year. Solos to 25-piece big bands. Here are just a few pics from over the last 20 years
