

Fred Bradshaw Trio

Sir Fredrick Bradshaw is a revered figure in the Tasmanian jazz scene, widely recognised for his contributions as a saxophonist and bandleader. His work is particularly noted for its influence on the development of jazz in Tasmania. The Fred Bradshaw Trio ensembles became staples of the local jazz circuit.

Bradshaw's performances are remembered for their vibrant energy and deep connection to the jazz tradition, blending classic standards with original interpretations

Even in recent years, Sir Fred Bradshaw has their notable live performance recorded in 2020 at The Duke in Hobart, where he was celebrated as a "living Tasmanian jazz icon".

The trio features Dan Sulz - piano, Mark Brothers- bass and saxophone virtuoso, arranger/composer, Sir Fredrick Bradshaw.

Arman & Co. is a vibrant Hobart-based jazz and blues band known for their smooth blend of Swing, Latin, and Ballads, often evoking the golden era of classic crooners. The group is fronted by Arman Bratamidjaja, a jazz vocalist originally from Java, Indonesia, who moved to Hobart in 2016. With a rich bass-baritone voice reminiscent of legends like Frank Sinatra and Johnny Hartman, Arman brings a nostalgic yet fresh energy to the stage.


The band typically performs as a quintet, featuring vocals, double bass, drums, guitar, and saxophone. They are a regular fixture at Tasmanian jazz events, including the Hot August Jazz Festival and the Clarence Jazz Festival, and have also played at notable venues like MONA and Pablo's.

Arman & Co. is celebrated for their ability to tailor performances to suit the mood—whether it's upbeat swing and Latin rhythms for dancing or soulful ballads that tell a story. Their shows are a journey through the timeless elegance of jazz, delivered with youthful charisma and top-tier musicianship.
