TUESDAY, 11 NOVEMBER

This dynamic Tasmanian jazz trio brings together three of the region's most accomplished and adventurous musicians. Anchored by the deep grooves of bassist Nigel Hope, the harmonic sophistication of pianist Dan Sulzberger and the expressive rhythms of drummer Konrad Park. The ensemble delivers a compelling blend of swing, cool-era jazz and modern improvisation.

Nigel Hope is a local jazz player and band leader among other things. He leads the Hope Trio, featuring Dan Sulzberger on keys, Konrad Park on drums, and Nigel himself on double and electric bass. The Trio plays high-quality jazz with a bunch of fun thrown in. Their song list is full of swing and Latin classics, some funky bits, and some unexpected but universally recognised and loved songs—keeping it just a bit more jazz.

The Trio will be playing songs from their new album.

Whether performing in intimate cocktail lounges or vibrant arts venues, this trio exemplifies the richness of Tasmania's jazz scene—bold, soulful and always evolving.
